Remote Learning - Please set routines that encourage a positive learning environment. Monitor students while using digital platforms and reinforce appropriate behaviors when working online. Students should check the Remote Learning Plan daily. If your child is completing work on a non-digital platform, please remember to submit student work to his/her teacher so that your child receives credit for the completed work. You may submit student work to teachers using any of the following methods:

- Take a picture of the work and email it to the teacher
- Mail completed work to school to the attention of your child's teacher: Franklin Borough School, Attn: TEACHER NAME, 50 Washington Avenue, Franklin, NJ 07416
- Drop off completed work at the school on Mondays and Wednesdays between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

To help keep our school community connected during remote learning, I encourage you and your child/ren to view the morning announcements and to participate in the daily Spirit Week activities. Third Marking Period - The third marking period ended on Friday, March 27, 2020. If your child is missing any third marking period assignments, please have him/her submit the completed assignment to his/her teacher this week, no later than Friday, April 3, 2020. Third marking period report cards will be posted in the *Realtime Parent Portal* on Monday, April 6, 2020.

School Closure - Franklin Borough School remains closed through Friday, April 17, 2020. New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy will provide further guidance as to when schools in New Jersey may reopen. Until that time, remote learning will continue.

Building Access - The school building is now accessible only by appointment. If you need a Chromebook or any other item from the school building, please email a school administrator to schedule a time to pick up the needed item.
