The Board of Education believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient to the growth and education of the whole child. It recognizes its responsibility to keep parents informed of pupil welfare and progress in school.

The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting pupil progress which shall include four written reports and one annual parent conference with teachers.

The Superintendent shall develop procedures for reporting progress which insure that both pupil and parent receive ample warning by mid-period of a pending grade of "failure" or one that would adversely affect the pupil's status, and enable the scheduling of parent-teacher conferences at such times as will insure the greatest degree of participation by parents.
