The Board acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self-government within the establishment of the schools.

Students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives and petition the Board. The Board will recognize the Student Council as the official voice of the student body for students in grades 5-8 provided that the charter, constitution, and bylaws of that organization shall have been approved by the Superintendent.

The Student Council shall be fully responsible for the planning and organization of its own government, student social events and fundraising projects.

The Superintendent shall establish rules and regulations to implement this policy which assure that all students have equal access to the student government and an opportunity to vote and hold office, and require fiscal accountability and adherence to Board policy for all financial aspects of student government activity.
