PUPILS 5830/Page 1 of 1 Pupil Fundraising Feb 76 Aug 98

The Board of Education will limit the solicitation of funds by and from the pupils of this district in order to protect pupils from unnecessary pressures and the instructional program from disruption.

"Pupil fundraising" means the solicitation and collection of money by pupils, on or off school premises, for any purpose associated directly or indirectly with the school district or under circumstances in which the solicitors are identified as pupils of this district.

Pupils may solicit and collect money on behalf of approved school organizations, provided the fundraising has been approved by the Principal.

The Principal shall approve all fundraising that involves door to door solicitation. Under no circumstances shall the Principal permit an activity requiring solicitation door to door unless the sponsor of the activity informs the pupils involved that they must be under the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian. The Principal shall notify the parents or legal guardians of pupils of any school activity that involves door to door solicitation and inform the parents and legal guardians that pupils shall not be allowed to participate in any such activity unless they are under the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian.

Out-of-school solicitation of money for school organizations must be approved by the Principal.

Pupils may solicit and collect money on behalf of nonschool organizations, provided the fundraising has been approved by the Principal.

No pupil will be permitted to solicit and collect money on school premises or at a school-sponsored event for the pupil's own benefit.

The Superintendent shall develop regulations regarding pupil fundraising that establish times and places in which pupil fundraising may be conducted and insure adequate accounting of funds collected. The building principal shall distribute this policy and the Superintendent's regulations to each recognized pupil organization.
