The Board of Education welcomes and encourages visits to school by parents, other adult residents of the community and interested educators. But in order for the educational program to continue undisturbed when visitors are present and to prevent the intrusion of disruptive persons into the schools, it is necessary to invoke visitor controls.

The Superintendent or building principal has the authority to prohibit the entry of any person to the school building or to expel any person when he or she has reason to believe the presence of such person would be inimicable to the good order of the school. If such individual refuses to leave the school grounds or creates a disturbance, the principal is authorized to request from the local law enforcement agency whatever assistance is required to remove the individual.

The Superintendent shall promulgate regulations that will protect pupils and employees of the district from disruption to the educational program or the efficient conduct of their assigned tasks.
