Alcoholic Beverages and Drugs on School Premises

The knowing possession, without legal authority, or knowing consumption of any alcoholic beverage by any person on school premises is a disorderly persons offense. The possession and use of a controlled dangerous substance without a prescription is a criminal act.

The Board of Education prohibits the possession and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, without the express written permission of the Superintendent, and the possession and use of any controlled dangerous substance by any person in any school building and on the school property owned by this Board. The Board will report to law enforcement officials and prosecute as appropriate any person who violates law and this policy, except that any pupil under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance or alcohol will be treated in accordance with law and Policy No. 5530.
